

INFORMATION GDPR

The General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016 (hereinafter referred to as "GDPR") is in force. Therefore, we address this information to our Customers and Potential Customers to inform you about how we process your personal data.

Data Controller

Your personal data controller, i.e. the entity which decides about the purposes and methods of processing your personal data is AB-LAB Beata Barkowska with its registered seat in Warszawa, address: Kirasjerów 10/16, 04-072 Warszawa (hereinafter referred to as AB-LAB). Providing the data is voluntary, but necessary in order to provide the service as ordered.

Obtaining information on personal data processing

Data collection and the processing purpose

We collect, use and disclose personal information with the consent of our clients, in accordance with legal requirements and regulations, in particular in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Act. The default consent for the collection and use of personal data by AB-LAB results from the fact that the customer contacted us or purchased goods or services and voluntarily submitted us personal information.

If you choose to provide your personal data to AB-LAB, we accept that you consent to the collection, use and disclosure of your personal data as described in this policy.

The customer has the right not to consent to the collection, use and disclosure of his or her personal data. Please note that if you do not provide us with information, the customer will not be able to use some functionality and services and communication between the customer and the company may be hampered.

Personal data is collected on the basis of information provided directly by the customer or by contacting our company. AB-Lab may ask for personal information, including: name, address, telephone number, email address, information about products purchased from us and opinions.

In each case, we respect the privacy of our Clients.

Data recipients

Your personal data may be transferred to other entities that process your data on their own behalf, including but not limited to:

- parties conducting postal or courier activities;
- banks and payment intermediaries – for the purpose of making payments;
- entities providing us with legal counsel, accounting, tax, claim collection, and advisory services.

Unannounced news

AB-Lab can send users e-mails related to his order (e.g. confirmation of receipt of order, confirmation of receipt of payment, confirmation of sending of products, etc.).

Personal data retention period

Your personal data will be retained for the duration of a contract (performance of services) and after its termination:

- data included in contracts - until the contractual claims become barred by limitation (up to 10 years from the contract completion date);
- for the purposes required under applicable law, in particular the obligation to retain accounting documentation, issue invoices, etc.;

Rights related to personal data processing

You have the right to access, rectify, delete, limit the processing of, transfer, object to the processing of and withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data at any time, which shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal (provided that the processing is based on consent).

Furthermore, if you consider that the processing we carry out infringes the provisions of GDPR, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the data protection supervisory authority.
